Minutes:

AMATYC Touchpoints (Matthew Kennedy)

The annual AMATYC conference is in Toronto November 17th-20th. Discount registration is available through October 7th. AMATYC also has virtual conference days December 2nd-3rd, which are extremely affordable.

Semi-Flipping a First Semester Calculus Course (Matthew Kennedy)

Matthew talked about his experiences with a flipped classroom approach to his Calculus course and demonstrated the in-class activity component using Nearpod to monitor student work.

Fun Activities to Engage Elementary and Intermediate Algebra Students (Luanne Benson-Lender)

Luanne demonstrated a few gamelike activities and talked about her experience using them in developmental algebra classes.

Equity and the Middle Tier of Students (Ben Aschenbrenner)

Ben led a group discussion on the idea that students can be broadly divided into three groups: a top tier (will succeed regardless of our input), a bottom tier (will not succeed regardless of our input), and a middle tier (the students whose success may be influenced by the instructor).
