	<p style="text-align: center;">David Feikes (Purdue University Northwest)</p> <p>This session will explore the foundation for a curriculum development project funded by the National Science Foundation to develop curriculum units for basic tertiary algebra classes. We will share our pilot materials and solicit feedback. The goal of the project is to prepare students conceptually and procedurally for college algebra. The practical and theoretical basis for the project will be described. Participants will engage in a discussion of algebraic structure, providing examples and soliciting their perspectives on structure. A sample unit will be provided to participants with materials that they can use in their introductory algebra courses. Finally, participants will be provided with opportunities for participation in the project.</p>
